Proposal to install a Third Bowls Green

To enable Torquay Bowls Club to achieve its aim to provide and promote bowls activities 12 months of the year, a proposal to install a new third bowls green is being considered. New and improved general club facilities have generated greater utilisation of the current available bowls facilities.

- ❖ Our current increasing membership of 850+ members sees Torquay Bowls Club as one of the biggest bowls clubs in Victoria. Membership has doubled over the past 3 years. Changes in the club's governance processes and planning, and a pro-active management resulted in a major increase in membership, and increased patronage from within local community.
- ❖ Our strong membership has helped to promote bowls within the Torquay community as a club for all ages.
- ❖ This project provides the opportunity to complement; upgrade; improve and enhance the general amenities in Taylor Park, with consideration to any environmental concerns.
- ❖ As a community resource and a popular hub in Torquay for local business activities and social events, community engagement is central to who we are.
- ❖ Through expanded club and community social programs, Torquay Bowls Club has increased connections with local sporting groups and community groups who regularly host bowls events and activities at the club.
- ❖ Torquay Bowls Club will be celebrating their centenary in 2024 and hope to celebrate the milestone with a new third bowls green.
- ❖ In 2016 Torquay Bowls Club was named as one of four finalists in the Bowls Australia Stockland Bowls Club of the Year.
