Introduction

This policy is the way all members should treat with respect other at the TBC events and on the premises

Scope

The defined proper behaviour to all by all at all times to ensure harmonious relationships are maintained to create a friendly club and experience

Definition

The way we all related to each other to make the TBC a happy and harmonious club to be enjoyed by all

Board responsibility

To ensure the correct policies are in place so all understand very clearly what is expected with each individual's behaviour toward others. To respond and act when members do not comply.

<u>All Members</u> of the Torquay Bowls Club will conform to the following code whilst on the club premises, or whilst representing the club in any circumstances:

- Treat everyone in a considerate, fair and courteous manner.
- Show respect to all persons regardless of their age, gender, race, culture, disability, religion or sexual orientation.
- Show respect towards each other, the club, employees, visitors and the wider community.
- Never engage in loud, violent, abusive, offensive or bullying behaviour.
- Never vilify, inappropriately touch or sexually abuse anyone.

This Code applies also to community bowling (barefoot bowls), training, coaching, social events and all approved activities.

Board actions: -

The Constitution allows the Board to sanction a member where the Board considers that a member has –

- Breached, failed, refused or neglected to comply with a provision of the Torquay Bowls Club Constitution or the Regulations
- Acted in a manner unbecoming of a member or prejudicial to the purposes and interests of the club, or another member
- Brought themselves, the club, bowls or another member into disrepute.
